Welcome! The Lunenburg Art Gallery Society was founded in 1972, with a mandate to promote the work and legacy of local artist Earl Bailly. Earl was paralyzed by polio as a toddler in 1905, and went on to achieve great prominence as a painter and printmaker. He used his mouth to hold brushes and tools, creating many hundreds of artworks celebrating Lunenburg's working waterfront. LAGS maintains a display of his paintings at the gallery and stewards a large collection of his work. In order to support this mission, we operate this community hub, selling work by local artists in lieu of fundraising.



Today LAGS has a growing list of around 150 members each year. Joining LAGS is a great way to be part of a thriving community of local artists and collectors. We are proud to exhibit work by artists of any age, medium, skill and experience level. We value diversity and celebrate our LGBTQ+ artists with a Pride show every summer.

Calling *all* members!

After decades of endless fundraising to keep a full-time staff person on board, our gallery is now run exclusively by a team of volunteers. Although we'd love your help, LAGS membership is not contingent on your time. But if you can, here's a list of ways to get involved:

1. Jump Right In!

Many dedicated members will join the board of directors, chair committees and help with the general "background" running of the gallery and its programs. If that's something that interests you, please get in touch!

2. "Sit" the Gallery

The next best way to help out is to take a shift as a gallery attendant. This mostly entails opening the gallery and helping visitors buy some art they love. Sitting the gallery is a great way to meet other members, artists and collectors, to talk about your own artwork or even make some art during your shift. We do our best to keep it as relaxed and enjoyable as possible. Shifts are 5 hours long from 11am-4pm. Fun fact: There are only 130 shifts in each season, and we have over 150 members each year!

3. Check out our "Jobs" Board

What's going on at the gallery can change with the tides, so we keep all our biggest 'most wanted' jobs on one page at lunenburgartgallery.com/Jobs. Add your name to some committees, be on-call for shift emergencies or taking over our social media are just some examples of jobs that are always available. Check off as many boxes as you can and we'll get in touch when we can use your help.

Are You An Artist?

Though all of our members are only supporters and art appreciators, most are active local artists. There are several ways to make use of the gallery throughout the year. Although LAGS is a not-for-profit gallery, it retains a 40% commission on all art sales in order to pay the rent and keep the lights on. If your work sells, you should receive a cheque for 60% of the sale price within 45 days. If you're registered for HST, let us know when you join.

Here are some of the ways you can make the most of your membership:

1. Monthly Exhibitions

All shows open on the First Friday of the month, April thru October. All members are invited to participate for as many of these shows as they wish. Each month has a different theme, which are listed on the website and included with your membership card. To enter each show, you'll need to register new artwork on the *last* Friday of the month and bring it during the intake days, the Sunday and Monday *before* each show, from 1-4pm.

As long as your work is registered by the deadline and arrives during (or before) intake, it will be included whether it fits the theme or not.

It might sound complicated, but once you get the hang of it you should get into the rhythm. You'll find all of our artwork display criteria on our registration page, *please read that section thoroughly before registering your work.*

2. Cards, Prints, Bookmarks, Jewelry and more...

In addition to the art on our walls every month, we have a few other items available by our artists all summer. Unframed prints, watercolours, jewelry and tiny multiples can be left at the gallery for the entirety of the season and replaced as they sell. We ask that you not drop any work off at the gallery unless you've registered them on the website first, or received confirmation from the chair of that committee.

Our inventory of art cards are purchased directly from members by the gallery for 50% of their retail price. These are accepted twice a year, at a maximum of 20 cards per artist each time. Keep an eye on the monthly newsletter for intake announcements/calls-to-artists.

3. Rent the Gallery

Once our season of exhibitions is over, you can host your own! Pop-up shows, holiday crafts, group shows and workshops are all great ways to use the space during the winter months. You must be a current LAGS member to rent the gallery, but you're welcome to share the space with non-member friends as you wish.
